(Newmarket, NH) Club Chameleon is going to be hosting a Ribbon Cutting Ceremony at their open house on Friday, May 12, 2006 at 6:00 pm. This event is to celebrate it's new 20' x 40' foot storage facility and to recognize and thank all those involved in this program's continue success.

The storage building was built in "true Club Chameleon team effort form." Local building contractors and parents of Club Chameleon children did the majority of the construction. In addition, many staff and teen volunteers spent hours painting and doing miscellaneous construction work on the new building located adjacent to the Newmarket Community Center.

It was extremely necessary to have a storage facility due to the amount of various equipment utilized with this outdoor wilderness program, i.e. kayaks, mountain bikes, assorted fishing poles, tents, snowshoes, cross country skis, and a variety of miscellaneous outdoor equipment. All monies used to fund this new construction were acquired by grants, donations, sponsorships, and the recreation's department's revolving account.
